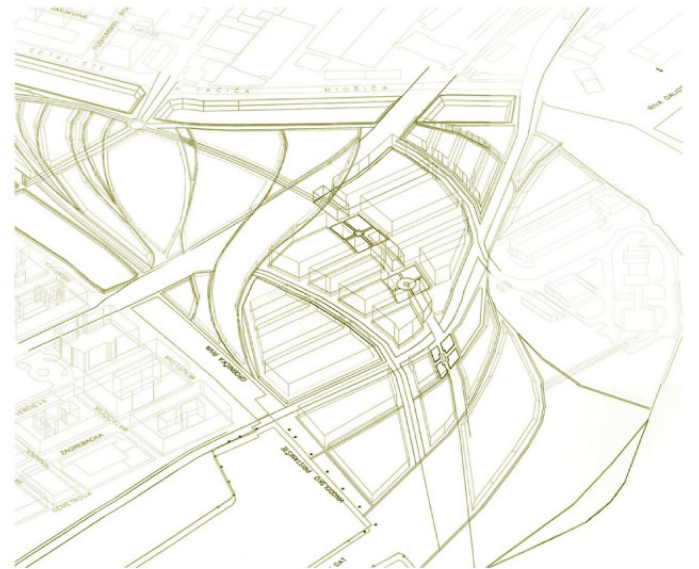
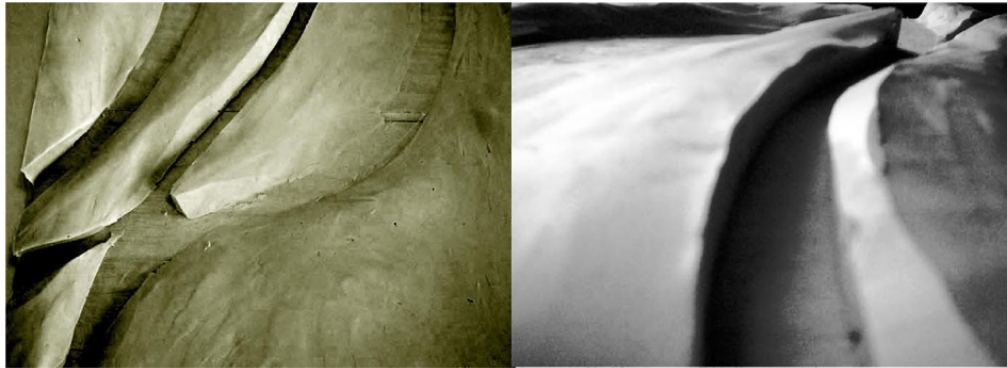


DESIGN: Park-na-Moru (Park-at-Sea)
